Lee Smith NASHUA, NH Champion Driver



SEEKONK, MA


Second Place Driver





John Evans ELLINGTON, CT Third Place Driver







Butch Walsh DOVER, MA Sixth Place Driver

WALLINGFORD, CT


Seventh Place Owner


Bobby White HULL, MA Eighth Place Driver

Tenth Place Owner




Ray Prew FOSTER, RI Eleventh Place Owner




Doug Cleveland NASHUA, NH Fourteenth Place Driver




Bob Pick
